

Caring For Your Floors ~ Tiles

Cleaning

The “Do”s:

- **Vacuum** or **sweep** floors before cleaning, to remove dust and dirt.
- Use a **clean mop**.
- Use **warm** or **hot water**.
- **Replace** the **water regularly** - mopping every room with the same dirty water isn't going to make the floor very clean!
- **Special tile cleaners** may be used. Please consult your tile provider regarding the best product for your particular tile. The surface should then be rinsed with clean water.



The “Don’t”s:

- **Do not add supermarket detergents** to your water. They can be the main cause of dirt sticking to the floor.
- Unless advised, **do not use acidic cleaners** or **scouring sponges** as these may cause damage to some tiles.



General Care Tips

- **Wipe up** any **spills** as soon as possible to avoid damage to certain types of tiles, and the grout.
- **Specialised grout cleaners** are available for removing any mould.
- **Specialised heavy-duty cleaners** can be used to help remove soap and other dirt build-up if necessary.
